

Little Angels FAQ



What are the hours of the program?

Little Angels is open 7:30am to 5:30pm Monday – Friday.

Are snack and lunch provided?

Parents are responsible for snacks, lunch and diapering supplies.

How are snow days handled?

If school is cancelled due to inclement weather, to ensure the safety of our teachers and families, so is our Little Angels program.

How will we be billed?

All Little Angels families are billed electronically through our ProCare system. Billing is done monthly.

What are the immunization requirements?

Our school and Little Angels program follows the State of Rhode Island's requirements for entering school. Families must show proof of a physical and immunizations prior to entering the program. We do not accept exemptions.

How do you communicate with families?

We pride ourselves on the close relationship you build with our staff, but we also utilize the tadpoles app. You will receive daily updates through this app.

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What is the minimum number of days to attend?

We do not offer a half day option. You may choose 3, 4 or 5 full days. Due to ratios, families must follow set days.

What makes Little Angels at Monsignor Clarke School unique?

Having Little Angels in a school setting makes it unique compared to other daycare programs. Teachers have access to the school campus (gym, library, outdoor spaces) so children aren't in one room all day.

What is the teacher to child ratio?

We operate at a 1 to 6 ratio. There can only be 12 kids maximum in each room with 2 adults.

How do you transition new students and families?

Before your first day, you will receive an email from the lead teacher who will share important information. You are also encouraged to set up a second tour with the admissions director and your child before their first day to "meet the teacher".
